This is text from the previous Collective Agreement that one side has not yet agreed to retain.

This is text which was in the previous Collective Agreement that has been removed in this proposal.

This is existing text (meaning from the previous collective agreement) which has been accepted by both sides.

This is text which has been newly accepted by both sides (i.e., this negotiation round).

This is language that both sides have agreed to remove.

This is text which is newly presented in this round of negotiations (and has not yet been accepted by both sides).

This is text which was in the previous collective agreement but has been moved FROM somewhere else (i.e., this is the NEW location for this text). If the text had not moved it would be **black**. (sometimes underlined and sometimes not)

This is text which was in the previous collective agreement but has been moved TO somewhere else (i.e., this is the OLD location for this text).

Comments:

- Anything <u>underlined</u> is new in this round of bargaining: e.g., <u>newly introduced</u>, <u>newly accepted</u>, <u>newly moved (NEW location)</u>
- Anything struck through is newly moved (OLD location) or newly deleted in this round of bargaining
- Black text is from the previous agreement that was not adopted by the other side's relevant proposal(s).
